Notice of Race

1. Event & Venue

The Royal Alfred Yacht Club takes pleasure in inviting you to compete in the Laser SB3 Liffey Fleet Racing Championship 2009, which will be held on June 12th 2009 under the Burgee of the Royal Alfred Yacht Club, in association with the Poolbeg Yacht Club, on the River Liffey.

2. Rules

The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.. In the event of any conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instruction shall prevail.

3. Advertising

ISAF Regulation 20 will apply

4. Entries

The regatta is open to boats of the Laser SB3 class. The person in charge must be a member of the Royal Alfred Yacht Club. Boats shall enter in writing by completing the official entry form, available from Eunice Kennedy, Royal Alfred Secretary (uniceeken@hotmail.com). The first 12 valid entries only will be accepted.

Entry fee per boat is 35.00 euros. Entries should be mailed to the Royal Alfred Yacht Club, PO Box 7512, Dun Laoghaire.

5. Schedule of Races

The fleet will assemble at the lift bridge at 10.25. The bridge will lift at 10. 30a.m. Racing will take place on the River Liffey from 11. 00 continuously until 15.00 subject to weather conditions.

6. Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions for entered boats will be available from the RAYC website at <http://www.rayc.ie>

7. Course

The course will be Windward/Leeward

8. Scoring

RRS 90.3 applies in that the Low Points System of Appendix A will apply, except that if 3 or less races are completed shall count, if 4 or more races are sailed there shall be 1 discard.

9. Penalties

Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

10. Mooring

The boats will be provided with raft up berths on the Poolbeg YC Marina over Thursday night.

11. Insurance

Each Boat's owner(s) and competing crews shall ensure that they are adequately insured against loss, damage or injury to persons. Boats or equipment at all times and however occurring and shall maintain sufficient 3rd party insurance cover. All Owners/competitors who sign the entry forms are deemed to have made a declaration that they hold such cover.

12. Liability

No responsibility shall be accepted by the Royal Alfred Yacht Club, Dublin Port Company Ltd, the Poolbeg Yacht Club, their directors, officers, members servants or agents nor any sponsor, nor those officials or members connected with the Event for any loss, damage or any other claim of whatever nature however arising or caused in connection with the participation in or intended participation in the Dublin Port Fleet Racing Championship.

13. Responsibility

The safety of the Boat and her crew is the sole and inescapable responsibility of the Owner(s) or the Person in charge whose obligation it is to ensure that the Boat is fully sound, seaworthy and is manned by an experienced crew with all the required safety gear. Neither either this Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions nor any action by the Royal Alfred Yacht Club its Organising Committee in any way limits the responsibility of the Owner(s) or the Person in charge. Attention is drawn to RRS Part 1 Fundamental Rules.

14. Prizes

A Perpetual trophy will be awarded to the overall winning boat and prizes for First, Second and Third overall.
