



Southern Championship 2010 Notice of Race



1. Organization and Venue

- 1.1. Crookhaven Harbour Sailing Club takes pleasure in inviting you to compete in the SB3 Ireland Southern Championship which will be held in Crookhaven, Co. Cork on 3rd & 4th July 2010.

2. Rules

- 2.1. Races shall be governed by the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing, the Prescriptions of the ISA, Laser SB3 Class Rules including SB3 Ireland Amendments, this Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions and any amendments thereto.
- 2.2. The event is designated Category C in accordance with ISAF Regulations.
- 2.3. In the event of conflict, the Sailing Instructions will prevail. This changes RRS 63.7.

3. Eligibility

- 3.1. The races are open to all SB3s fulfilling the class membership criteria and rules. The owner, or a joint owner or a nominated representative of an organization owning the SB3, must be a current Full Member of the Class Association.
- 3.2. Any changes of helm or crew during the event must be applied for in writing and agreed by the Race Committee in writing in advance of the change being made.
- 3.3. All competitors will be required to declare their crew weight at registration.

4. Conditions of Entry

- 4.1. Yachts may be subject to scrutiny before or after any race at the discretion of the event Race Committee, the SB3I Measurer and SB3I Committee.
- 4.2. All yachts shall comply with the prescriptions set out in the current Class Rules, the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions from the time of the first warning signal of the first race until returning ashore following the final race of the series. Class rules C5.1(6)(iii) and C5.1(7) will not apply if the items have been removed whilst moored following racing for the purpose of refilling/charging only.

5. Entries

- 5.1. Entries shall be submitted at registration.
- 5.2. No entry will be accepted without the appropriate fee in cash.
- 5.3. The entry fee is €100 per boat.

6. Scoring

- 6.1. The Low Points Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply.
- 6.2. 6 races are scheduled, of which 3 shall constitute a series.
- 6.3. One score shall be discarded if 4 or more races are sailed.

8. Sailing Instructions

- 8.1. Copies will be available for collection at registration.
- 8.2. The courses to be sailed will be Windward/Leeward; full details will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

9. Race Results

- 9.1. Race results will be posted on the official notice-board after racing each day.

10. Protests

- 10.1. The procedure for protests shall be in accordance with the current ISAF Rules.

11. Prizegiving

- 11.1. The presentation will take place following racing on Sunday, 4th July.
- 11.2. Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd overall, 1st in the silver fleet and 1st in the bronze fleet.

12. Crane and mooring

- 12.1. A crane will be available for launching and recovery of competing boats at the times indicated in NoR section 7. The crane is located in [Rock Island](#).
- 12.2. Trailers will be stored in Rock Island for the duration of the event.
- 12.3. Moorings will be provided for competing boats in Crookhaven harbour.
- 12.4. Boats may be required to share moorings.

13. Disclaimer of Liability

- 13.1. Competitors participate in the Championship entirely at their own risk; see RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority, SB3 Ireland and their officers, members and volunteers, will not accept liability for loss of life or property, or personal injury or damage caused by or arising out of the SB3 Southern Championship 2010, including any pre-championship training at the championship site, and competitors take part in the championship entirely at their own risk. The establishment of the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions in no way limits or reduces the complete and unlimited responsibilities of competitors being solely and entirely responsible for the management of a boat they are sailing. It is the responsibility of each competitor to participate in a race or to continue racing. A competitor is wholly and exclusively responsible for his or her personal accident and health insurance. A skipper is wholly and exclusively responsible for his or her third party liability insurance on the boat that he or she is sailing.

14. Insurance

- 14.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of €3,000,000 per event or the equivalent.
